

How do I insert an image?

I want to include an image in the REDCap survey I am using for eConsent.

Images can be inserted into a REDCap form or survey using the 'Descriptive Text' field type.

To insert an image into a form/survey:

 Within the 'Online Designer', you can add a new field to your form and select the 'Descriptive Text' field type.

2. On the right-hand side is a box where you can upload the image file you want to insert. Click 'Upload Document'.



3. 'Click 'Choose File', select the image file you wish to insert, and then 'Upload Document'.

4. Finally, choose 'Link' OR 'Inline Image' as the display format of your attached image.

- a. Select 'Link' if you would like the image to appear as a popup window.
- Select 'Inline Image' to embed the image within the REDCap form.
